

## 2006 Aquatic Plant Annual Harvesting Report

OLMD began training employees on harvesting equipment May 15, 2006. Actual harvesting began June 5, 2006 and ended October 15, 2006.

Total area harvested was 530 acres of our 570 permitted acres.

One hundred thirteen 10 cubic yard truck loads of plant material were removed during the harvesting operation.

The majority of harvested material was Eurasian water mil foil and water celery. The other plant material common to Okauchee Lake was removed in lesser amounts due to their proximity to targeted plants.

Annual cost of harvesting operation was \$285,000.

No violations of our permit occurred in 2006 and no changes to the plan are anticipated for the 2007 season.

OLMD applied for and obtained a permit to chemically treat approximately 150 acres for 2006. The total area treated was approximately 75 acres. Our plan is to repeat this process for the 2007 season.
