## ArtServancy Artist Exhibition By Frankie Garr Month of July

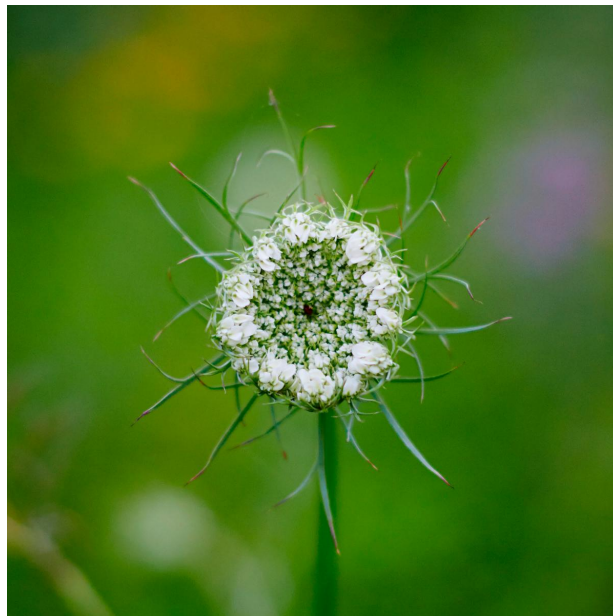
ARTservancy began in September of 2018 and has now grown to include partnerships with five conservation organizations within southeastern Wisconsin.
